JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards*, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards*, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards*, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards* in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards* in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards* in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

*A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. To obtain a junior identification number contact juniors@akc.org BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

CATALOG PRE-ORDER

Catalogs may be pre-ordered by checking the box on the entry form.

Catalogs are **\$5.00 pre-ordered** and will include all events.

Payment may be included with entry fees.

A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the show for \$7.00.

ENTRY FEES

When a dog is entered in more than one class (regular or non-regular) in the same event, the highest priced class is considered to be the first entry. In addition to two classes for one dog in Conformation or in Obedience, a dog may be entered in a Conformation class and the second (reduced fee) entry may be in Obedience or vice versa. **12-18 Month conformation entries do not qualify for the Puppy Class entry fee.**

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6 p.m., WEDNESDAY, February 15, 2023 AT THE SHOW SECRETARY'S ADDRESS: MRS. PATRICIA MIMS, 1603 WINDLOCH, RICHMOND, TX 77406. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted after entries have closed as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows."

*ALL signatures for overnight deliveries for entries **MUST BE WAIVED**.*

Entry fees listed on page 6.

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The AKC. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2) A \$3.50 AKC recording fee will be required for the first entry and a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog in Rally. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 5.)

Entries received without fees or signature cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes received by telephone are not acceptable.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED IN THE EVENT THAT A DOG IS ABSENT, DISQUALIFIED, EXCUSED BY THE VETERINARIAN OR JUDGE, OR BARRED FROM COMPETITION BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE. No entry fees

will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

Transfers to different classes in Obedience and Rally will be allowed as specified in Chapter 1, Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations. *The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.*

ATTENTION OBEDIENCE AND RALLY EXHIBITORS: THE AKC RULES REGARDING PRACTICING OF DOGS ON SHOW GROUNDS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC Rules will be allowed within the show grounds.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Judges will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

SHOW REGULATIONS - cont'd.

Show and Committee Chairs may exhibit at this show.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise CONTROL and RESTRAINT over their children while attending these shows. Parents are responsible for any damage done by their children.

The show site will be available to exhibitors when the Show Committee has completed preparations for the show, which is expected to be approximately 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 4, 2023. SSCH show hours will be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 4, 2023 and 8:00 am to one hour after the judging of Best of Breed on Sunday, March 5, 2023.

Crates and grooming equipment, and dogs may be left in the arena Saturday night, but exhibitors do so at their own risk. The **Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston** nor **Haras Hacienda** assume any responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exercise pens will not be allowed inside the arena. There is ample room outside the arena for exercise pens.

Blowers are allowed but there is limited access to electrical outlets.

ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE ARENA IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE JUDGING OF BEST OF BREED ON SUNDAY.

The show-giving club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. THE SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB OF HOUSTON RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY DOGS FOUND IN DISTRESS IN A VEHICLE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AND ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The State of Texas is under a rabies alert.

Proof of a rabies vaccination may be required. Tags are not sufficient for proof of vaccinations.

NOTICE: The show-giving club reserves the right to cancel the events if extreme weather conditions threaten the well-being of dogs and participants, per the American Kennel Club guidelines issued July 28, 1995.

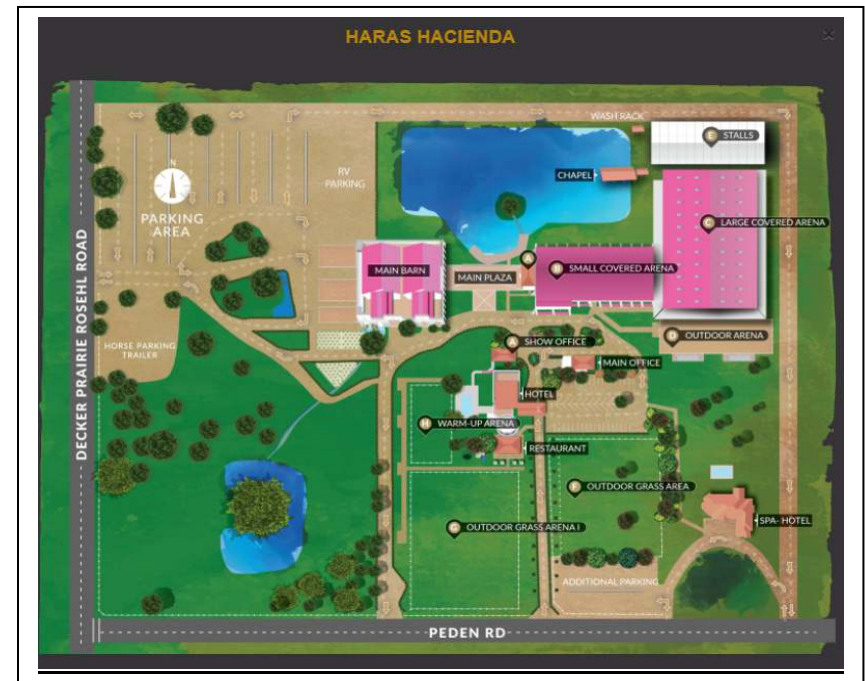
