Entering Mixed Heights or Mixed Classes: Separate entry forms must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per trial, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Confirmation of Receipt of Entry: An initial e-mail will be sent out as entries are processed, typically within 24 hours of the entry being received. Move-ups are confirmed by a new emailed confirmation being sent. If an exhibitor has multiple dogs entered, the updated email will only be for the dog that had the move-up. Final confirmations will go out after the trial has closed.

Change of Entry: Entry changes emailed to the Trial Secretary are not official until the exhibitor has received a return email confirmation from the Trial Secretary.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

SET-UP AND CHECK-IN

The site will be open for set-up at 7:00 am on Friday and at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 am on Friday and no earlier than 8:00 am on both Saturday and Sunday.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, dogs that are blind, and dogs that are taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes are not eligible to participate.

Transfers will be allowed for obedience classes if requested in writing and presented to trail secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judge is available and the trial has not reached its limit. Please refer to the Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16a or Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15 for a complete description of the procedure. For transfers in the show weekend please submit the paperwork to the trial secretary before the start of the following trial.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all skills safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston or any official thereof.

All dogs must be always on leash when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing in the ring.

REFUNDS

Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of the trial may be obtained provided that a veterinarian's certificate and a request in writing is received by the show secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Ringside

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Arbitration agreement

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form at these events.

Trial secretary agreement

Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston will allow the trial secretary the option to enter or allow dogs co-owned by the secretary to be entered and may handle dogs in the rally and obedience trials.

Crating is available indoors. X-pens will not be allowed indoors. Be prepared to stack crates if needed. Crates may be left overnight at the show site; however, **Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
